



- 3. Now take the scissors and cut a hole in the side of the cups. The same size as the end of the toilet roll.
- 4. You can cover the roll and the cups with tape to make them look nice.
- 5. Next, push the ends of the roll into the cups.
- 6. Now you have speakers with no batteries and no wires.

Take a photograph of your small speakers. Then the class will decide which is the best. We will put the one with the best design into our school magazine next month. Remember size is not important but the way it looks is.
