



The man says, 'All right, all right. I'm dying to know. So, how do I become a monk?' The monks tell him that he has to travel the earth and tell them how many blades of grass there are and the exact number of stones there are. 'When you find these numbers, you will become a monk', they said. The man decides to do it.

Almost 51 years later, he returns and knocks on the door of the monastery. He says, 'I have travelled the earth and have found what you have asked for. There are 2431,107,985,647 blades of grass and 801, 221,707,451,447,658 stones on the earth.' The monks are surprised. 'Congratulations. You are now a monk,' they say.
